Management of Change (MOC) – Overview



- Today's Business Environment Is Driving Change At An Unprecedented Level.
- The Pace Of Technology Change, In Particular, Is Accelerating, Requiring Businesses To Oversee Transitions To New Processes And Procedures On A Regular Basis.
- Effective MOC Processes Allows The Company To Maintain A Constant State Of Evolution And Facilitate Periods Of General Business Change, Allowing Workers To Remain Motivated And Productive During The Introduction Of New Technologies Or Procedures.
- MOC By Nature, Is Intended To Facilitate Organizational, Technology, Procedure, And Equipment Change, So Attention Must Be Paid To Each Constituent Part Of The Whole.
